Mr. Mueller indicated he would attempt to continue the conversation with PW as this could be simply viewed as needed maintenance of a city building.
- Mr. Mueller also put in an order to replace the damaged plaque; however he indicated he was having trouble finding the language that was on the original plaque.

D. May Historic Preservation Month Activity
