
# Every day, children as young as 12 are sold for sex in Milwaukee.

For juvenile victims of the \$32 billion human trafficking industry, housing and quality social services remain a critical need. Most states' laws allow children to be arrested for prostitution, even children below the age of consent. This means many girls end up in jails or juvenile facilities where the trauma of their exploitation is not addressed.

In 2012 there were fewer than 250 shelter beds for commercially sexually exploited children in the United States. In Wisconsin there are only 6 beds available to the Justice Department when a child is rescued from a trafficker.

## Residential aftercare

Exploit No More is opening a dedicated residence to provide opportunities for healing to girls ages 12 to 19. The house will be staffed with professional, trauma-informed caregivers focused on restoring children to lives of purpose and peace in a home-like setting. Between staff salaries, purchase and renovation of a property and ongoing advocacy, our first-year costs are estimated at \$979,000.
