West Allis/West Milwaukee Fatalities



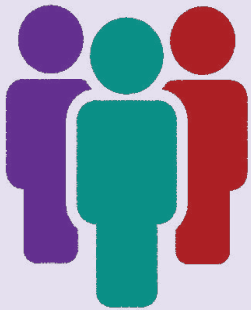
In 2015 West Allis had **28 FATAL** overdoses
